

Wagga Wagga Art Society Guidelines 2022

1. Members elected to co-ordinate workshops ensure that:
 - Workshops are organised and run smoothly.
 - Non-members participating in workshops will pay 20% more than members.
 - All workshops are viewed as a draw card to obtain new members and to support WWAS with financial contribution.
 - Be accountable for all monies received and paid out.
 - All monies must go through the treasurer and banked in the appropriate way.
 - Payments to tutors & models will be done through the accounting system.
 - 50% deposit must be paid before confirming workshops and will be non-refundable.
2. All active members contribute to WWAS above membership fees by:
 - 10% from the sale of paintings.
 - \$1 each day for tea/coffee, bikkies when in the Studio.
3. People wishing to hire the studio for classes & personal gain:
 - Pay \$50 hire per session.
4. Members wishing to use studio for personal exhibitions are responsible for:
 - Artworks, advertising, hanging, cleanup, and so on.
5. All members using the studio are responsible for:
 - Leaving all areas in a clean and orderly state.
 - All windows must be closed & blinds pulled down.
 - Fans, lights, air conditioners, & heaters are off.
 - Ensure that all doors are locked.
 - Easels must be put back in store room.
 - Kitchen/wet area left clean and tidy.
6. All artwork hung in the studio on a monthly rotational basis is the responsibility of the artist.
7. If using key from key box please ensure it is returned to usual place and the box is secured.
8. Minimum age of members is eighteen (18) years.

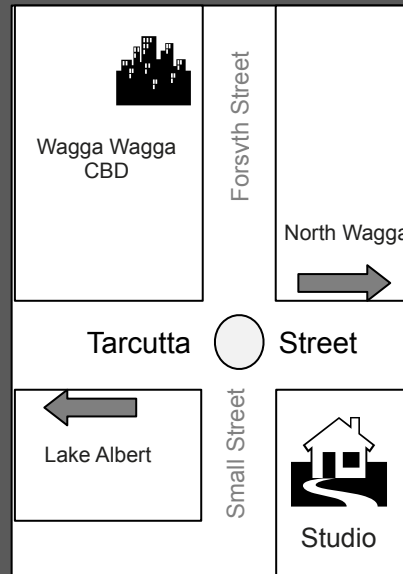
Critiques Members are happy to guide and assist you with your art as it progresses.
